## A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

In mid-May 2021, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) announced several policy changes and updated recommendations regarding COVID-19 safety precautions. State and local governments may still adopt or interpret these changes accordingly based on local infection rates and case trends.

**Requirements for using masks, social distancing and other safety precautions for schools, public transportation, hospitals, prisons and various other public facilities remain in place. This includes staff, patients and visitors to Lake Taylor Transitional Care Hospital.**

- The revised CDC changes applied to persons who have been fully vaccinated, and not a general “all clear” for people who aren’t fully vaccinated or those who have not received any vaccine inoculation.
- Persons who have not received a vaccine or haven’t yet received both doses of vaccine are encouraged to get fully vaccinated.
- Until fully vaccinated, wearing masks and social distancing are still called for by the CDC.
- Some in-person visitation by family members is permitted for most patients or residents. See the most recent CDC requirements on our Homepage for more information.
