A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Effective March 14, 2020, we began restricting all visitation to Lake Taylor Transitional Care Hospital. This decision was not made lightly and we understand the hardship this puts on everyone. Our primary duty is the health and wellness of our residents. The CDC, CMS, and the Virginia Department of Health are changing the guidance to post-acute facilities daily.

A recent directive had advised to severely limit visitation. We are concerned about the spread of COVID-19. This action is no guarantee that the virus will not make it into our facility but it will reduce the chances of this happening.

The following are a list of actions that we have implemented:

- NO visitors in the building
- No patient LOAs
- Patients are only allowed to leave the facility for essential medical appointments, as determined by their medical provider
- Patient Care Plan meetings will be rescheduled or held via conference call
- All patient laundry will be labeled and done in-house at no cost to the patients

For communication with your loved one, telephones are in all the rooms and can be used free of charge. As always, patient representatives will be contacted for any change in your loved one's condition.

Thank you in advance for your understanding and in partnering with us during this national health crisis. We at Lake Taylor take our responsibilities very seriously and are doing what we feel is prudent at this time. We welcome your questions and will work through all the answers with you.
